

Campus Parking/Vehicle Control Notice - 2026 University Entrance Ceremony -

Due to expected heavy congestion around the school and on-campus areas on the day of the university entrance ceremony, we strongly encourage new freshmen students and your parents to use public transportation for your safety and the smooth operation of the ceremony. However, if you must drive for an unavoidable reason, please refer to the parking guidelines below.

In addition, to prevent congestion on campus and ensure pedestrian safety, vehicle traffic will be restricted in certain areas (Main Gate Rotary → Preiffer Hall(Main Hall) → Student Union Building). **When the campus parking lot is full, vehicle entry to the school will be completely restricted.**

1. Effective Date: February 27, 2026 (Friday), on the day of the ceremony

2. Campus Parking Guidelines

- a. Free Parking for Visitors from 10:00AM to 2:00PM (based on the time of departure)(Vehicles leaving after 2:00PM will be charged.)
- b. Only ECC parking lot is available.
- c. No illegal parking or parking on the side of the road: strict enforcement with sticker placement

3. Vehicle Control on the Campus: If the parking lot is full, vehicle entry will be completely restricted (no access to the campus or parking lot).

4. Road Control for Pedestrian Safety

- a. (All-day Control) Main Gate Rotary → West Gate → ECC parking lot entrance
- b. (All-day Control) Back Gate → In front of ECC parking lot entrance → Human Ecology Building(Morris Hall) entrance → ECC parking lot entrance
- c. **(When the Campus Parking Lot is Full) Complete restriction on vehicle entry to the campus - no vehicle access allowed**
